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INTRODUCTION

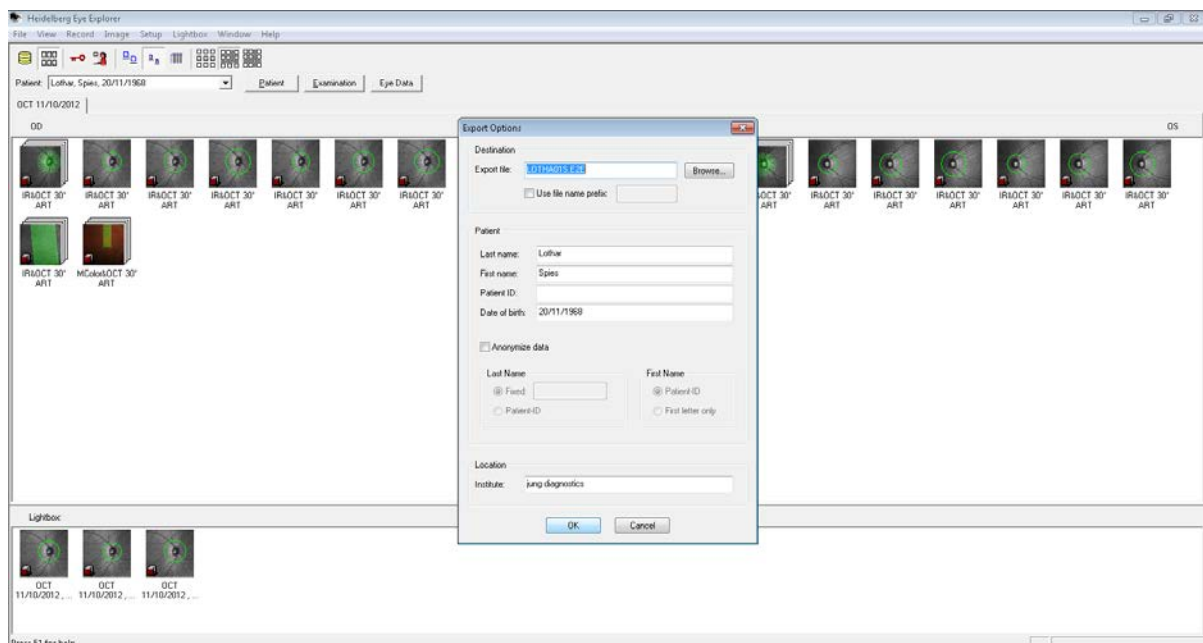
This manual describes how to use an internet-browser based file transfer system to upload retinal OCT scan data to the OCT reading center.

EXPORT OF SCAN DATA

Export of Retinal OCT scan data using Heidelberg Eye Explorer

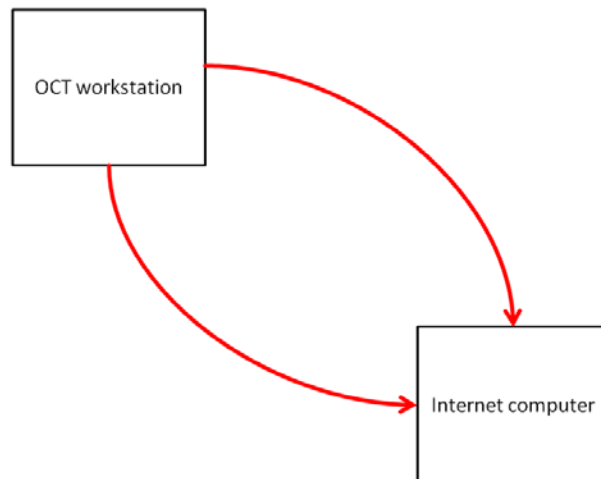
The procedure for image export is as follows

- Drag and drop all scans that you would like to export into the lightbox (at the bottom of the database window)
- In the lightbox, use your mouse to select all images by holding the “Shift” key and clicking each of the images.
- Right-click and choose export as E2E
- Select destination folder using the “Browse” tab and click OK



Transfer Retinal OCT scan data to workstation with internet access

Once all images have been exported to the destination folder, copy the files to a USB stick (or jump drive, external hard disk, etc.) or transfer via LAN to a computer with an internet connection.



If the internet connection at your institution does not allow the upload of sufficiently high volumes of data and thus electronic transfer is not possible, burn your data to a CD or DVD, and mail it to:

Please visit the website www.neuro-oct.com, which provides further information on the BENEFIT11 study and contains the electronic upload and transfer portal.

Login

It is the responsibility of your Principal Investigator (PI) to register you as an OCT technician of the BENEFIT11 OCT study with the **Neuro OCT Reading Centre** in Zurich. Upon registration, you will receive your username and a password for your first login from the email address neuro-oct@usz.ch (please ensure that your spam filter allows incoming emails from this address).

After you have received your login details, please visit the website:

www.neuro-oct.com

and click on the LOGIN tab in the main menu. You are prompted for your username and your password. Enter your username and password as requested. You can change your password after login at any time. *Your username will remain unchanged for the entire study.*

File Transfer of Certification Scan

In order to become certified as an OCT technician of the BENEFIT11 OCT study, the first scan you will have to upload to the central server will be a certification scan (see also OCT data acquisition manual for further details).

After Login click on the link "Browser based transfer to jung diagnostics GmbH". Subsequently, the upload frontend window titled "Medizinischer Datendienst" shows up. Please select a language (German, English, Russian, and French) by clicking on the top right box.

You will receive a confirmation email once the data was successfully retrieved from the server.

Once you have submitted a scan that meets the quality criteria, you will be registered as a certified OCT technician for the BENEFIT11 study, which allows you to subsequently acquire and upload patient OCT scans.

Please note: any patient scan acquired before the date of your personal certification will automatically be rejected by the OCT reading centre.

File Transfer of Patient Scans
